On Monday, January 30, 2023, Charlene Mary Ann (Moxley) Meyer, a deeply loved wife, mother and grandmother, passed away peacefully at Assumption Nursing Home surrounded by the love of family after an over 5 year battle with Bensons' syndrome.

Charlene's children and grandchildren were her greatest joy. Her favorite place was to be surrounded by them with loudness and laughter. She enjoyed

playing carbles, hand and foot, randomly dancing to her favorite songs and hosting family parties. All were welcome and no one ever left her house hungry. She was a devoted caregiver to her mother, up until her passing in 2018.
