Earl P. Ehresmann, age 56 Bismarck, ND March 29, 1949 – March 23, 2006

Earl P. Ehresmann, age 56, died March 23, after a long struggle with cancer. A memorial service will be held at Corpus Christi Catholic Church in Bismarck, ND on Monday, March 27, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. with a gathering of friends and family to follow. A visitation will be held from 10:00 a.m.- 1:00 p.m. Thursday, March 30, 2006, at the Wenner Funeral Home in Cold Spring, Burial will be in the St. Boniface Cemetery in Cold Spring, MN. Earl Ehresmann was born in Richmond, MN to Andrew and Evelyn (Eisenschenk) Ehresmann. He was raised on a farm in Cold Spring. Earl graduated from St. Boniface High School in 1967. He joined the United States Air Force in 1968 and was assigned to the 56th Special Operations Wing for 15 months in Vietnam, during his tour overseas. Upon his Honorable Discharge; he attended the St. Cloud Vocational Technical Institute as an Instrumentation Technician. He married Darlene Schwegel in 1973 in Cold Spring, MN. Earl worked for the Montana Power Company in Montana shortly after his graduation. In 1977, he started work at the Coal Creek Power Plant in Underwood, ND, where he worked for over 28 years as an E & I Technician. Earl loved to run, bike, ski and do other aerobic exercise. He set North Dakota State records competing in the Prairie Rose State Games. He enjoyed working with the people at St. Edwin's Catholic Church, the American Legion, the Washburn School and other community events. In 1998, Earl won the Jay A. York Community Service Award from Cooperative Power for his exemplary public service. Earl was a

50 year plus member of the Catholic Order of Foresters, a member of Washburn Council 9174 Knights of Columbus, a life member of the Washburn American Legion Post #12 and a member of the Disabled American Veterans. He is survived by his daughter, Paris and Brian Otremba and their children, Carsen and Avery of Apple Valley, MN, his son, Tanner Ehresmann of Farmington, MN; brothers, Joe and Barb Ehresmann of Bloomington, CA, Vic and Danna Ehresmann of Cold Spring, MN; sister, Mary Jane and Joe Schmitt of Luxemburg, MN. He is preceded in death by his parents and sister, Diann.
