Despite suffering from cancer for the past 8 years, Ed remained a steady presence in his family home, up to the end showing the warmth and humor that characterized his life. Ed was a dedicated and hard-working farmer his entire life, growing various crops over the years, as well as raising dairy cows on their farm in Rockville. He was a proud member of Knights of Columbus and the Legion of Mary Auxiliary, as well as a parishioner at Mary of the Immaculate Conception, in Rockville. He is survived by his wife Bernadine, his four children, Henry (Kathryn) Massmann, Ronald (Kathleen) Massmann, Mark (Mary) Massmann, and Julie (Scott) Reberg.
