Gene Welle, age 82, of Cold Spring died January 30, 2026 at the St. Cloud Hospital. 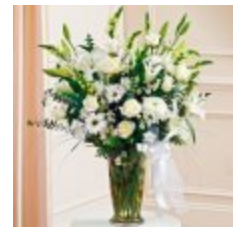
