Jacob was born in Havelock, ND to Jacob Sr. and Margarita (Caseman) Kirschmann. He married Dorothy Haugen on October 11, 1947 in Rapid City, SD. Jake served in the U.S. Army during WWII. He was a tank driver in the 813th Tank Destroyer Battalion, part of the 3rd Army under General George Patton. He received the Purple Heart, Bronze Star and Presidential Unit Citation. He worked for Kirschmann Manufacturing as a Farm Machinery Dealer Representative. He traveled throughout the U.S. helping Farmers and Dealers with their machinery. Jake loved cooking, fishing, gardening, building and flying remote control model airplanes, and spending time with his family, grandchildren and great-grandchild. Survivors include his children, Brad (Gerry), Elizabeth (Gerald) Peterson, Daniel (Beverly); grandchildren, Brad Jr. (Aimee), Courtney (Nick) Taaffe, Edward (Giselle) Weymouth; great-granddaughter, Zoey Taaffe, and several brothers and sisters. He was preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy.
