Ervin went back working with heavy equipment and Molly went to work at Luther Haven Nursing Home in Montevideo. She worked at the nursing home for 15 years. In 2002 Ervin passed away and in 2010 Molly came back to Cold Spring to be closer to her children. Molly volunteered at Assumption Nursing Home and helped at church once in a while.

Mary (Rick) Olson; siblings, Eileen (Chuck) McKinnon, Tom Russell; 7 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren.
