Mildred A. Wicklund, 97, passed away on April 10, 2025, at Hilltop Care Center, Watkins, MN. A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 26, 2025, at Mary of the Immaculate Conception Church, Rockville, MN. Inurnment will be at the Calvary Cemetery in Rockville.

She learned to golf at Angushire Golf Course and spent many hours golfing during her retirement.

She loved dogs. Growing up she had dogs, but her mother did not allow them to be inside. In 1971 that changed with the addition of Spooky to the family. In 2006 they adopted Toby from the Humane Society. Toby spent many years taking care of Arne and Millie. When Toby passed away, Millie started babysitting the neighborhood dogs and her house was a regular stop for dogs

on a walk to stop and get a treat.
