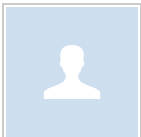

I will never forget your instant, loving, and capable care when Vince Eikmeier Jr or I had an emergency and needed help.

I got to have so many fun times with you, though my noise and

exuberance "plucked your nerves" - maybe more than anyone else. I know I provoked the "wrath of Patti" more than once with my shenanigans, but I hope that you derived more comfort and stability from us than frustration from us while living with us.

As I grew to a teenager and an adult, you were back in Minnesota, and I saw you less often, you were nevertheless the same Aunt Patti when we visited, ALWAYS quick to grab me hard and not let go with your fierce hugs and non-stop love. It didn't matter how much time had gone by, or how many times I screwed up. You had a quick temper, but you were also so quick to forgive. I can't remember how many things of yours I broke. You showed your toughness and your love in equally fierce measures. Your love of your own kids and grandkids was also so evident.

As a mother myself, bringing my boys to spend time with you at your house was so special. You welcomed them with open arms just as if they were your own grandchildren.

I love you so much, and my visits to Minnesota will never be the same without you. I'm ugly-sobbing even thinking about being there without seeing you.

I know that my grief is as nothing compared with your immediate family.
