



## Ralph Bernard Zumwalde

Ralph served in the Army during WWII from 1942 to 1946 as Staff Sergeant, serving in the European Theatre, and was awarded the Bronze Star. He was self-employed as a building contractor and retired in 1986, living in Richmond his entire life. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, bowling, golfing, gardening, and reading. He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Parish, the Richmond American Legion, Volunteer Fire Department, Senior Citizens, Catholic Order of Foresters, Catholic United Financial, Civic & Commerce, and past member of the Central MN Builders Assn.
