Richard served in Korea from 1950 – 1952 where he was awarded the Purple Heart. He worked at Nash Finch Company for 37 years, after retiring he drove for the Richmond Bus Service for 9 years. Richard loved old time dancing, singing, fishing, hunting, men's coffee clutches, his garden tractor and his pickup truck. Above all he loved his family. Richard served as an usher and as a member of the choir in the Mary of the Immaculate Conception Church. He was a former member of the Rockville City Council and served as Mayor. Richard was a member of the Cold Spring American Legions, Korean Last Man's Club, Knights of Columbus and was a past Grand Knight, Rockville Fire Department for 22 years, and

was a charter member of the Rockville Lions Club in which he received the Melvin Jones Award.
