Willie served in the Army from 1941 – 1945 in the European Theater. He worked at The Wenner Co. as a plumber for 19 years. In 1964 he started Hansen Plumbing & Heating, until his retirement in 1979. Willie was Key Master of St. Boniface church for 20 years. He loved playing cards, bowling, baseball, and collecting cans. Willie also enjoyed snowblowing, mowing lawns, and gopher trapping. He was a member of St. Boniface parish, Catholic United Financial, and the Cold Spring American Legion and VFW.
